Other activities

Please note that all CFMUNESCO activities will be held at "Liceo Classico - L.C." except for:

Opening Ceremony - it will take place at the medieval "Chiesa di San Francesco", former Church of St. Francis, nowadays deconsecrated and used as conference room.

Closing Ceremony - it will take place at "Teatro Ristori", the city theatre which is dedicated to the famous Italian actress Adelaide Ristori (born in Cividale del Friuli in 1822).

Lunches of Thursday, Friday and Saturday, plus Friday evening Social Event – they will take place at the Convitto canteen (CNPD).

Social Event – it will take place at the Convitto canteen (CNPD), there will be a buffet dinner for everyone, a dj set, there won't be any alcoholic beverages and smoking is forbidden within the School's canteen. There is no dress code, so everyone will be able to dress as she/he wants. National costumes are admitted too.

All the above mentioned locations are within walking distance of Liceo Classico.

Behavior

CFMUNESCO is a simulation of the United Nations Organization which follows THIMUN rules, therefore students are expected to behave like diplomats of the country they represent. In addition, students are a representative of their own school. This double representation implies that students must always behave properly during the conference itself and outside (public transportation, streets, places such as shops, cafés etc.). Smoking is strictly forbidden in all the structures destined to CFMUNESCO activities.

Dress code

For all participants at CFMUNESCO (Delegates, Student Officers, MUN-Directors and Advisors) an appropriate outfit is mandatory during the whole time of the conference. This dress code has been fixed in order to prove our respect towards the countries that are represented at the Conference.

For girls – the choice should be: a suit, a smart separates (either trousers or skirts) or a formal dress.

For boys – a formal suit, shirt and tie or similar alternative such as blazer or jacket with formal trousers, shirt and tie, dark shoes.

Delegates and admins should not wear clothes, jewelry or accessories which are inappropriate or draw unnecessary attention.

Inappropriate dress includes, but is not limited to:

- Denim clothes and sport shoes (trainers, etc.);
- Too short skirts;

- National costume or military attire;
- Flags of any kind;
- Brightly colored and/or spiky hair;
- Facial piercings (extended to earrings) and/or body art (piercings).
